TRC Bells Creek Bridge Deck Replacement

Project Overview

The Bells Creek Bridge Upgrade project includes the replacement of existing bridge girders, by upgrading the existing abutments and piers, and installing a new deck surface. This project also includes the improvement of both bridge approaches, with approximately 460 metres of road upgrade and bitumen seal. SGPS has been engaged to perform the Project Management and Inspectorial Services to assist with the delivery of Bells Creek Bridge Deck Replacement within the Atherton Tableland Shire. SGPS has already assisted TRC with the delivery of this project having managed the review of design documentation, the creation of request for tender documentation, and in the assessment of tender submissions and completion of the recommendation report. SGPS will continue with the delivery of this project through both Project Management and Inspection services.
