

Castle Hill Goat & Cutheringa Track Upgrade

Project Overview

As part of the Works 4 Queensland packages SGPS were engaged by the Townsville City Council to provide a Project Officer to carryout administration duties and oversee the construction process. The GoatTrack provides a popular recreational facility for residents and tourist alike, with upwards of 8000 people visiting the hill each week. Upgrades were carried out to improve track walkability, legibility, safety and erosion control. This was done under strict guidlines to ensure the construction process did not disrupt the local resisdents along with facilitating the track users. This project was managed from design phase through to construction.
