Project Overview

SGPS was engaged by the Department of Main Roads to supply a Administrator's Representative and Senior Site Engineer to assist with contract administration and to carry out a general surveillance of the civil construction works. The duplication process consists of approximately 3km of new pavements, stormwater drainage, signalised intersections, watermain relocation, lighting upgrade and footpath works within the scope.
